
## SENTENCE COMBINING

**COORDINATION** creates a COMPOUND SENTENCE: 2 or more INDEPENDENT CLAUSES (SIMPLE SENTENCE Subj. Verb)



**SUBORDINATION** creates a COMPLEX SENTENCE: 1 INDEPENDENT CLAUSE and ONE or more DEPENDENT CLAUSES (DEPENDENT CLAUSES <u>don't</u> have a Subj. and Verb)

(no internal punctuation)

Dependent Clauses are introduced by Subordinating Conjunctions:

after	because	than	when

## SENTENCE ERRORS:

RUN-ONS: 2 OR MORE SENTENCES INCORRECTLY JOINED

remedy: coordination or subordination

FRAGMENT: INCOMPLETE SENTENCE (lacks a Subj. or Verb)

remedy: add to an existing sentence
